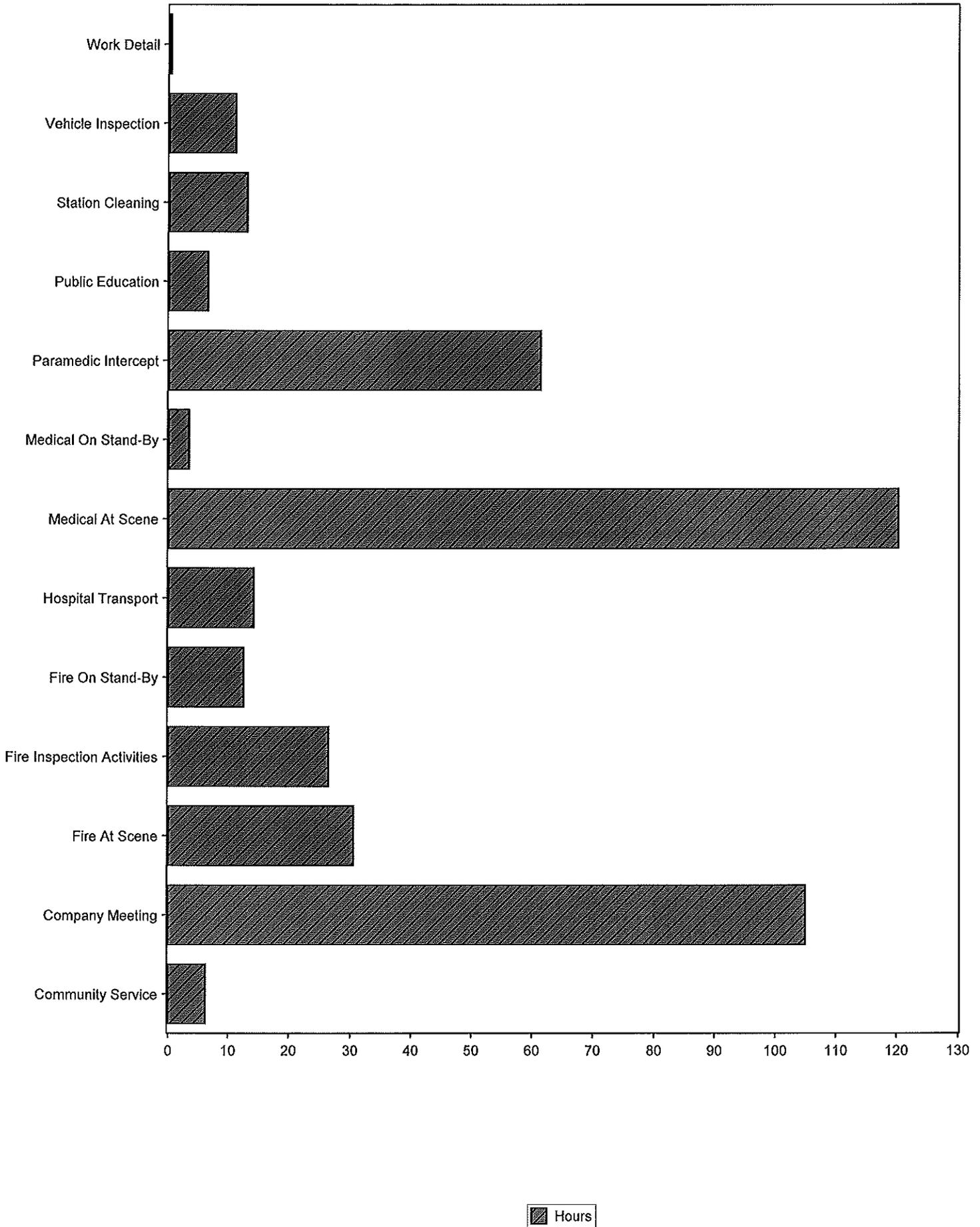

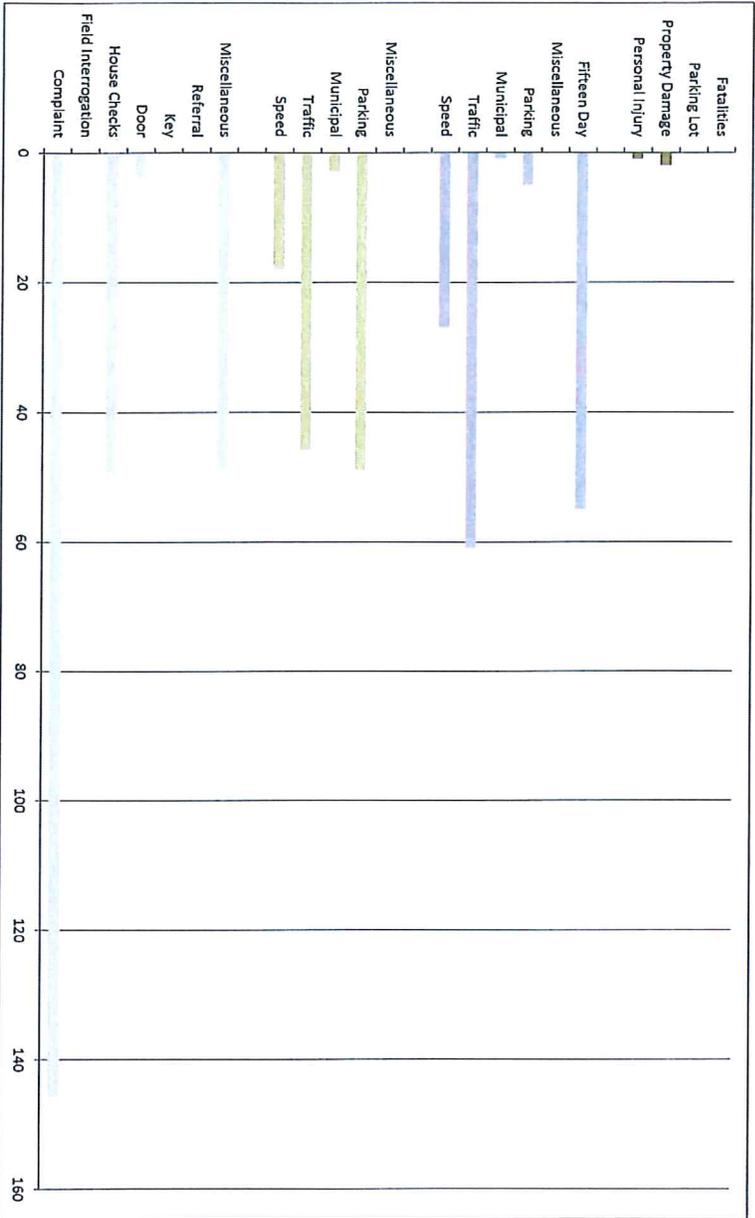

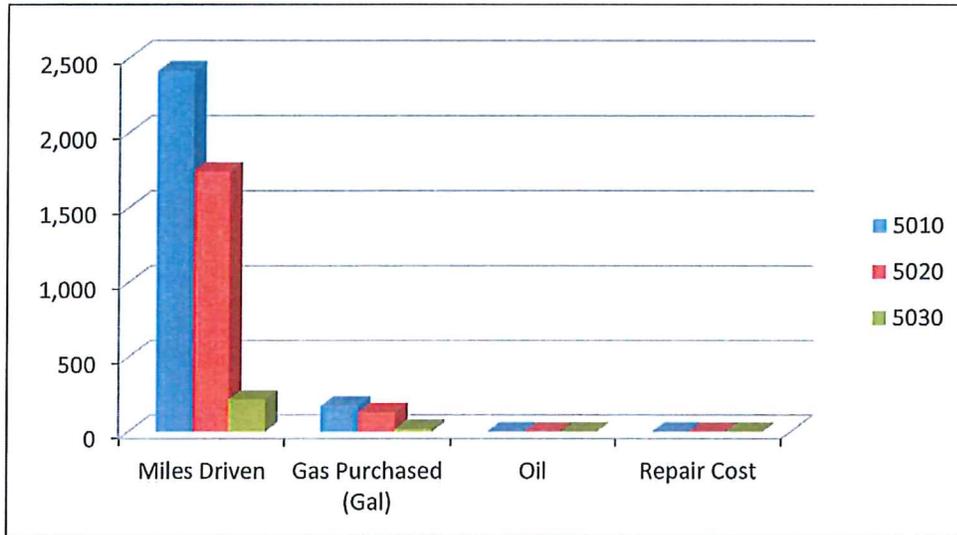

Mr. Jesse Daily addressed the Plan Commission presenting plans for a 3 Season Room/Patio Covering at The Cheel, 105 South Main Street. Submitted plans are to enclose the existing patio. The ceiling is clear to allow sunlight and will also be a shield from rain. The addition will be constructed of metal and wood frame material which will support a series of removable glass panels along the entire east and south façade. Planner Censky asked for clarification on the material used to construct the roof. Mr. Daily explained that the roof will be constructed out of clear fiberglass plastic. The only changes that may arise to the structure may be the amount of windows installed.

Commissioner Gengler inquired as to how this area will be heated and cooled. If it is hot outside, there will be fans and in the winter, infrared electrical heat will be used.

Only the windows will be removed in the spring and summer; the structure and roof are permanent. There is an option for installing screens when taking out the window panels, and this is something Mr. Daily is still considering.

Commissioner Kucharski asked for clarification regarding the definition of the structure as being "removable". The Certificate of Appropriateness stated that "The improvement, 3 season room/patio is classified as "removable" and shall be added or removed without destroying the integrity of the original structure." Mr. Daily shared that the idea is to make this space an outdoor entertaining space. Planner Censky explained that the Historic Commission's explanation is that this structure can be easily removed without affecting the integrity of the building.

The current heating units will not be used because they are gas and cannot be used in an enclosed structure. Infrared electric heating will be installed and is placed overhead. The current units may be moved outside for effect.

Planner Censky shared that this fully complies with all zoning requirements.

MOTION by Commissioner Gengler, **SECONDED** by Commissioner Kucharski to approve the 3 Season Room/Patio Covering for The Cheel, 105 South Main Street. **MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.**

- C. Review and approval of Sign Application for Two Tails Grooming Salon
304 North Main Street, Contingent on Village Staff and Planner Censky
Approving Compliant Background Color When Submitted

Planner Censky informed the Plan Commission that the sign design submitted this evening from Rachel Zastrow for Two Tails Grooming Salon, 304 North Main Street fully complies with the Sign Code. Planner Censky inquired as to if Ms. Zastrow still has a temporary sign in the sign structure. There is a non-compliant sign currently displayed. Planner Censky recommended approving this compliant sign with the condition that the current non-compliant sign be removed. The sign is internally lit.

MOTION by Commissioner Luedtke, **SECONDED** by Commissioner Kucharski to approve the Compliant Sign Application for Two Tails Grooming Salon, 305 North Main Street with the Condition that the Current Non-Compliant Sign be Removed. **MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.**

It was noted that President Mobley and Administrator Robertson have had a lot of conversations with potential new businesses but, partly because of the nature of the conversations, we do not hear much about them.

D. Relationship Between TBRC and TBA

The previous discussion flowed directly into the next topic regarding the roles and responsibilities for the TBA and the TBRC. Unfortunately, neither Member Mrugala nor Member Daily were at the meeting, so nothing was resolved this evening.

Trustee Lange commented that part of the reason for the TBRC was the absence of strong leadership from the TBA. The TBRC has done some nice things in the Village and helped to inject new life into the TBA. Now that the TBA is much stronger, we need to either dissolve the TBRC or find a way to serve the community.

There are a lot of talented people on our committee who want to "Do" something. We need more activities for them to be more involved in the community.

The possibility of forming a committee that would help the TBA with the Fun Before the 4th activities next year was discussed as well as the option of doing some joint activities with Mequon similar to the Taste of Mequon.

It was decided not to meet in August due to scheduling.

The general consensus is that our feeling of community is one of the most attractive aspects of Thiensville and we would like to use technology to promote that as much as possible. Member Giuntoli will spearhead this initiative.

RESOLUTION NO. 2016-04

TO AUTHORIZE THE LOAN FROM THE VILLAGE OF THIENSVILLE SEWER UTILITY TO THE VILLAGE OF
THIENSVILLE CAPITAL PROJECTS FUND

WHEREAS, the Village of Thiensville authorized the Main Street Water Main Project (the "Project") with an estimated cost of \$1,272,000; and

WHEREAS, approximately \$460,000 of Village of Thiensville Tax Stabilization funds were used to finance the cost of the Project; and

WHEREAS, approximately \$412,000 of existing Village of Thiensville Capital Projects Fund monies were used to finance the cost of the Project; and

WHEREAS, the aforementioned activity has resulted in reducing the available cash balances of the Village of Thiensville Capital Projects Fund by approximately \$400,000; and

WHEREAS, approximately \$650,000 of the cost of the Project will be assessed to the property owners and will be paid back over 10 years; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Thiensville Sewer Utility has available, unencumbered cash balances not required for ongoing operation and maintenance.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Trustees of the Village of Thiensville does hereby accept and approve the recommendation of the Village Administrator and hereby authorizes a loan from the Village of Thiensville Sewer Utility to the Village of Thiensville Capital Projects Fund in the amount of \$400,000 for a term of _____ years at a rate of _____% per annum with payments to be made in accordance with the debt service and amortization schedule attached hereto and marked as Exhibit "A".

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this loan may be repaid without prepayment penalty at any time.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that all interest accruing under the terms of this loan shall be deposited in and inure to the benefit of the Village of Thiensville Sewer Utility.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this loan may be closed at a time acceptable to the village administrator.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this loan is hereby authorized pursuant to Wisconsin Statute Section 62.12, Wisconsin Statute Section 67.03 and Wisconsin Statute Section 67.12(12).

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the proceeds of this loan are to be used solely for the funding of the deficit cash balance of the Village of Thiensville Capital Projects Fund.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Village President is authorized to execute this loan and any other documents necessary to effectuate the intent of this resolution.
