OF PUBLIC HEARING

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, that the Village Board of the Village of Thiensville will meet in the Village Board Room on Monday, June 6, 2016 at 6:00PM at the Village of Thiensville Municipal Building, 250 Elm Street, Thiensville, Wisconsin, to amend the Comprehensive Land Use Plan to reclassify the site at 104 Spring Street as commercial from residential to render this Plan consistent with the zoning.

The Comprehensive Land Use Plan for 2035 was adopted on October 7, 2008. This Plan serves as the official guide for the physical development of the Village whereas the Zoning Code is the law under which development must follow. According to Section 66.1001 of the Wisconsin State Statutes, before any land use decision can be made by the Village, these two documents must be consistent with each other.

The following will be considered:

To amend the Comprehensive Land Use Plan to reclassify the site as commercial to render this Plan consistent with the zoning for the new owner of the property, Port Washington State Bank.
