

VILLAGE OF THIENSVILLE
ADMINISTRATION POLICY
FOR USE OF
VILLAGE DUMPSTER SERVICES

I. Purpose of Policy

To establish guidelines for special residential use of a 6-yard dumpster under the supervision of the Department of Public Works.

II. Need for Policy

- A. To define who is allowed to request the use of special Village dumpsters.
- B. To identify what rubbish can be disposed in the special Village dumpster.
- C. To establish an accessible location for delivery and pick up of the dumpster.
- D. To establish a dumpster use fee schedule as adopted by the Thiensville Village Board.

III. General Guidelines

- A. Authorization for use of Village dumpster:
 - 1. Only residents residing in single or two family buildings are authorized to use a special Village dumpster.
 - 2. Apartment buildings having three or more family units will not be allowed the use of a Village dumpster.
 - 3. Commercial or industrial establishments will not be allowed the use of a Village dumpster.
 - 4. Contractors including all general construction, plumbers, electricians, landscapers, tree trimmers or any other paid contractors will not be allowed the use of a Village dumpster.
- B. Waste allowed in dumpster:
 - 1. Allowed: Do it yourself home improvement rubbish: wallboard, plaster, lumber, carpeting, tile, ceramic, pane glass, roofing, hard cover and soft cover books, clothes and other nonperishable materials. If necessary, contact the Department of Public Works for further information.

C. Wastes NOT allowed in dumpsters:

1. All Recyclables: Aluminum cans, steel (tin cans) bi-metal, steel/aluminum; newspapers, magazines, cardboard; glass bottles jars (green, brown, clear), plastics #1 and #2, ovens, refrigerators, freezers, air conditioners, hot water heaters, microwaves, washers, dryers, dishwashers, dehumidifiers; auto batteries, oil, brush, grass clippings, leaves, yard wastes.
2. Metal and Concrete: Steel, aluminum, iron, metal fencing, concrete blocks or slabs and any other metallic or concrete materials.
3. Other Wastes: Daily household garbage, auto tires, gas cylinders, ammunition or explosives, paints, solvents, thinners, aerosols, antifreeze or any other hazardous wastes.

IV. Dumpster Charges

A. Charges as established by the Thiensville Board of Trustees:

1. The charges for the use of a 6-yard dumpster is:
\$100, or \$250 for Remodeling/Roofing material, each time used.

V. Procedure for Requesting Use of a Village Dumpster

- A. Residents may write, phone or personally request a dumpster by contacting the Department of Public Works (242-0180) or the Village Clerk's office 242-3720.
- B. Approved use of a Village dumpster will be by permit issued at the Thiensville Municipal Building, 250 Elm Street, after the appropriate fee is determined and paid.
- C. The employees of the Department of Public Works will be responsible to deliver and pick up the dumpster from a mutually accessible site.
- D. Dumpster use will have a limit of two weeks at any one site and will be removed by the Department of Public Works on call (See Item V.A)
