2019 Safety Town

The Mequon-Thiensville Optimist Club, in conjunction with the Thiensville Police Department and the Mequon Police Department will sponsor the Safety Town Program again this year. The dates are from July 22nd through August 2nd.

Safety Town is a nationally sanctioned program for children who enter 5K for the first time in the fall term. The program runs for two hours each day, emphasizing through visual aids, demonstrations, handouts and practical experience on a miniature town constructed at the school.

In addition to officers from the Thiensville Police Department and Mequon Police Department, student volunteers are also present to assist the officers.

This year's Safety Town will provide two sessions for the students. The first session runs from 8:00 A.M. to 10:00 A.M., and the second session is from 10:30 A.M., to 12:30 P.M. Registration preference is on a first come, first serve basis. Sessions are limited to 42 students. Attendance is required for both weeks.

Registration forms for Safety Town may be obtained at the Thiensville Police Department, 250 Elm Street, Thiensville. The registration fee for the course is \$25.00, which covers all materials.

Registration will start on Monday June 3rd. Registration may be dropped off or mailed. No early registration will be accepted. If mailing the form it may not be postmarked before June 3rd. Registration forms can be found online at <https://www.village.thiensville.wi.us/>
