We wanted to give you advance notice that in our continuous commitment to provide the best possible emergency services to Village residents, we will be conducting several live burn training evolutions at a property located at 640 Green Bay Road over the next week. These training opportunities will close Green Bay Road to through traffic during several periods of time. Our plan is to close traffic to the public at Lake Bluff and Heidel Road. Affected Green Bay Road residents may enter from the south after checking in at the road closure point. We have to close the road to allow the necessary water to be trucked in because there are no functional hydrants in the direct area of the training.
